

Guidelines for LGF awards

1. Applicants should *normally* be resident within a 20-mile radius of Birmingham city centre (including term-time students at universities and colleges)
2. Applicants should *normally* be under the age of 25 years, although full-time students and others on very limited income above that age will also be considered.
3. The value of grant will necessarily be limited by the amount of capital in the fund, but should *normally* be for organ lessons (with a teacher approved by the Trustees) or vouchers to purchase organ music. Recent awards have typically been up to £450.
4. While priority would *normally* be given to first-time applicants, this does not preclude the possibility of candidates making more than one application after a suitable period of time has elapsed at the discretion of the Trustees.
5. Applications need to be supported by a reference from a suitably qualified and knowledgeable person, acceptable to the Trustees.
