

- Applicants should *normally* be resident within a 20-mile radius of Birmingham city centre (including term-time students at universities and colleges)
- Applicants should *normally* be under the age of 25 years, although full-time students and others on very limited income above that age will also be considered.
- The value of grant will necessarily be limited by the amount of capital in the fund, but should *normally* be for organ lessons (with a teacher approved by the Trustees) or vouchers (to purchase organ music) to the value of up to £300.
- While priority is *normally* given to first-time applicants, this does not preclude the possibility of candidates making more than one application.
- Applications need to be supported by a reference from a suitably qualified and knowledgeable person, acceptable to the Trustees.
